DT-100 INSTALLATION PACKAGE

The DT-100 is a compact, high performance, low-cost terminal that consists of a display screen and a detached keyboard. The keyboard has 101 keys arranged in typewriter, numeric pad, and function key sections. The DT-100 can communicate with a variety of host computers that run the TRS-XENIX operating system, including the Enhanced Model II, Enhanced Model 12, Model 16, and Model 16B.

Connecting the DT-100

See the manual that comes with your DT-100 for instructions on connecting the DT-100 to your host computer. Be sure these connections are properly made before installing the DT-100 according to the steps below.

Installing the DT-100

The DT-100 installation package consists of one diskette. You must install this on your hard disk at the host computer; but before doing so, please read all these directions. This lets you become familiar with the entire procedure and helps make the installation smoother. During the installation, be sure to watch the screen and answer all the prompts.

- Turn on the hard disk(s) and all peripherals and then turn on the computer.
- 2. When your screen displays the login prompt, type:

root <ENTER>

3. At the root prompt (#), type:

install <ENTER>

4. The screen shows the Installation Menu, which contains these prompts:

- 1. to install
- q. to quit

Type 1 <ENTER> to install the DT-100 terminal.

5. The following prompt appears:

Insert diskette in Drive Ø and press <ENTER>

Insert your DT-100 installation diskette in Drive 0 and press <ENTER>. The screen then displays the name of the package, the version number, and the catalog number.

After you install the DT-100 terminal, the screen shows the following message:

Installation complete - Remove the
diskette, then press <ENTER>

Remove the diskette and press <ENTER> to return to the Installation Menu. The screen shows:

- l. to install
- q. to quit

Press q to quit and return to TRS-XENIX.
